General notes on the data

This report uses the data that was available on 14 July 2022. Figures for the school, LA and national may change following checking, discounting and validation, and the figures given here may therefore differ from what the final data published by DfE and in ASP.

3-year trends are provided using data from 2018 and 2019, as formal assessments were cancelled in 2020 and 2021.

In KS2, the cohort figures shown in the table correspond to pupils recorded with an assessment. The numbers eligible for the average score and progress measures may be different, and will be reflected in the labels on the charts.

In KS1 and KS2, for ease of reading all pre-key-stage standards are combined into a single grade of PKS. The full breakdown showing each standard individually is available through Perspective under LA Reports.

KS2 progress figures have been estimated by NCER, pending DfE releasing their methodology and calculations for prior attainment under "life after levels". This will be updated once the DfE figures are available.

Transition charts showing progress from EYFS to KS1 are not generally available as this KS1 cohort were not assessed under EYFSP, but where schools took part in the optional assessments in 2020 these charts are shown using that data. Please remember that these optional assessments have no official standing.

Notes on reading the graphs

A speckled grey bar running the full height of the chart indicates that there are no pupils in that group.
A blank column therefore indicates that no pupils achieved the benchmark.
(This does not apply to charts showing trends)

Charts with blue bars show average marks.

Charts with green bars show where pupils have met a specified threshold (and those with orange and red bars show where pupils have not met the threshold).

Charts with purple bars show average progress scores at KS2. Negative figures indicate that pupils made less progress than pupils with the same starting point nationally. Confidence intervals are shown so that you can determine whether a progress score is significantly above or below average.

A grey diamond marker indicates the national average for that group to achieve the pass mark or the expected standard and, where relevant, a small black mark indicates the national average for a high score/GDS. On multi-coloured charts, this corresponds with the top of the green bar(s).

Charts with spotted shading show pupils' transition from the previous phase or key stage.

For KS1, this shows pupils' EYFS outcomes in reading, writing, number and SS&M and outcomes in Y1 phonics.
For KS2, this shows pupils' outcomes at KS1.

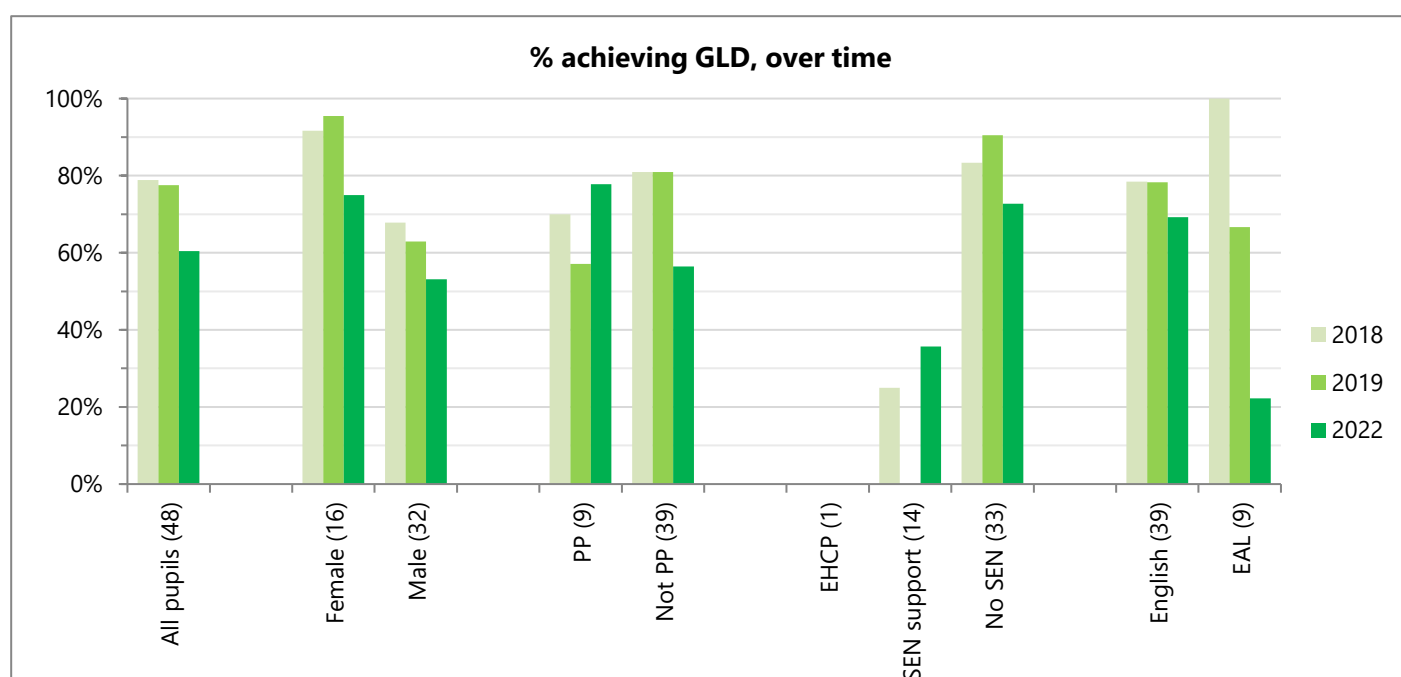
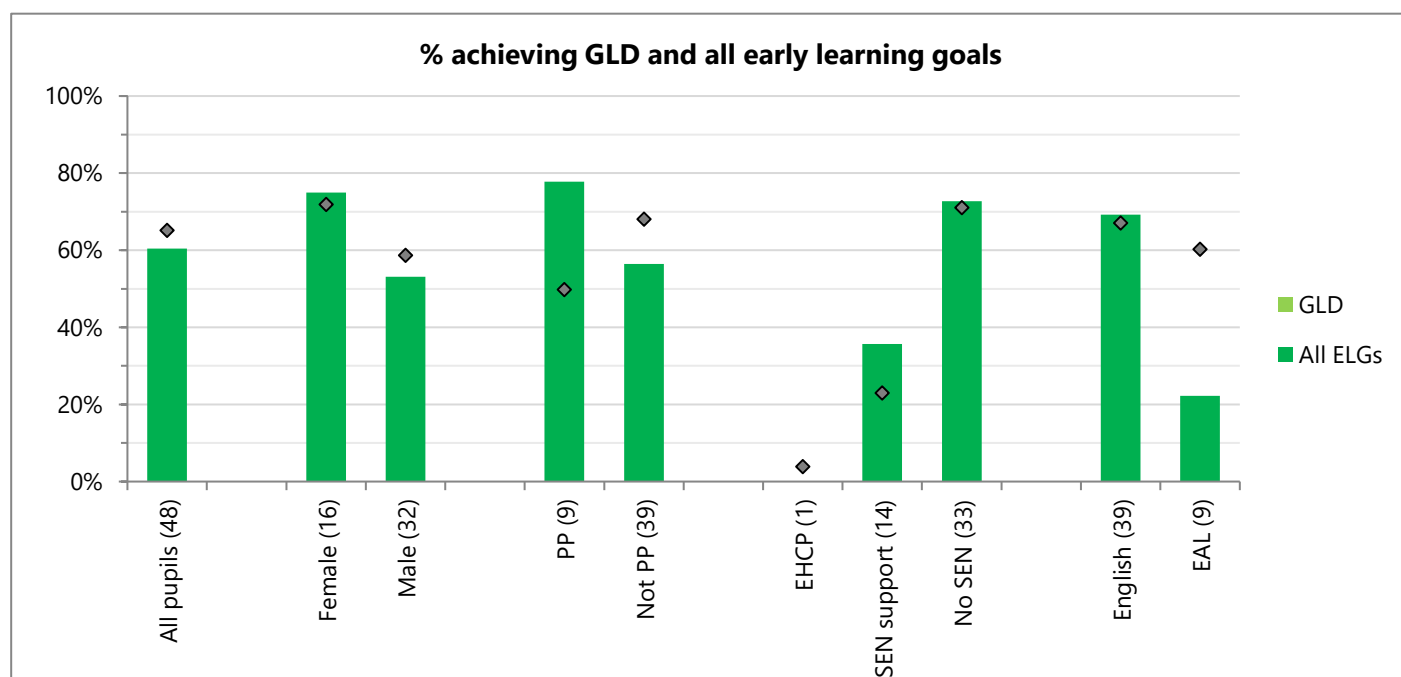

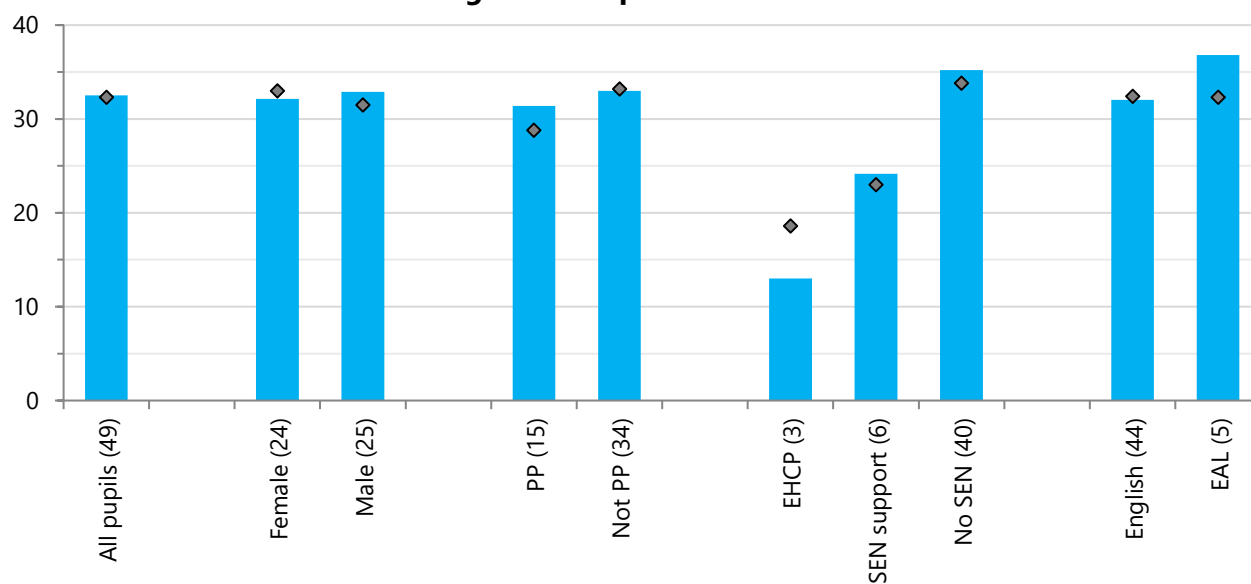
% achieving phonics standard in Year 1



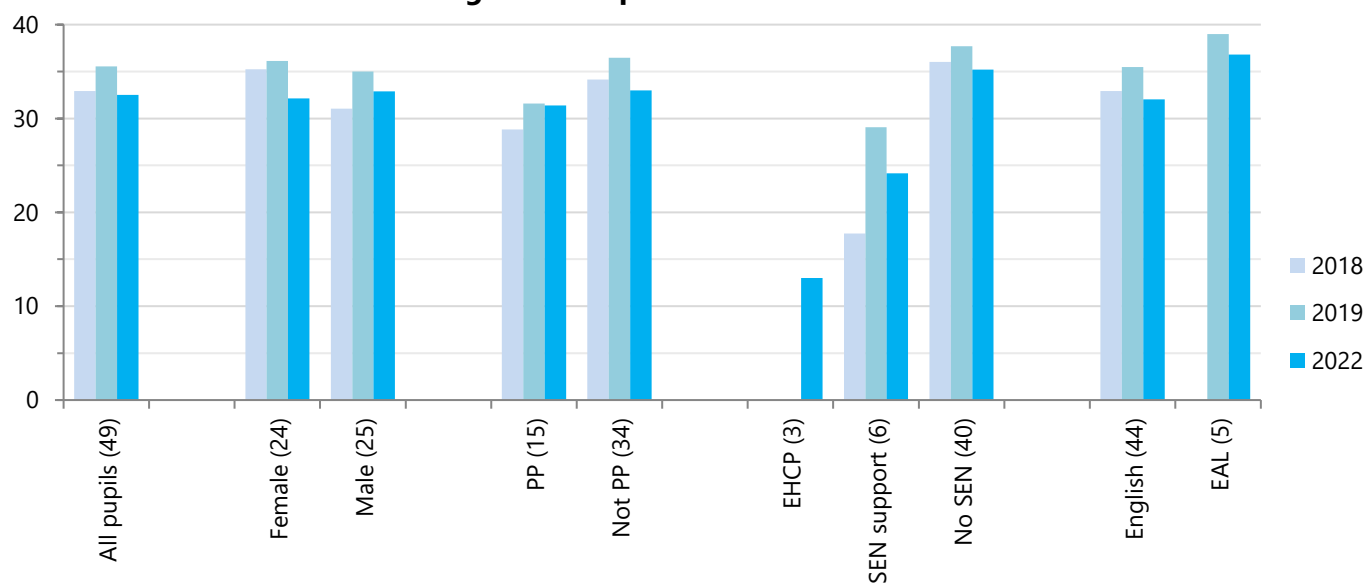
% achieving phonics standard in Year 1



Average mark in phonics standard in Year 1



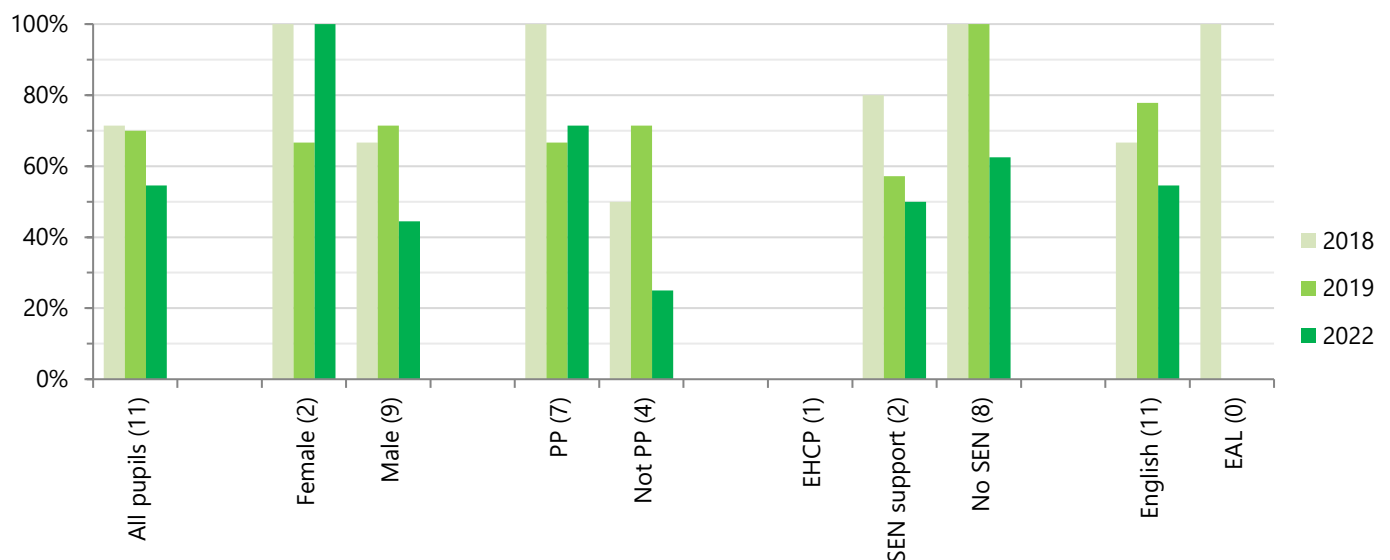

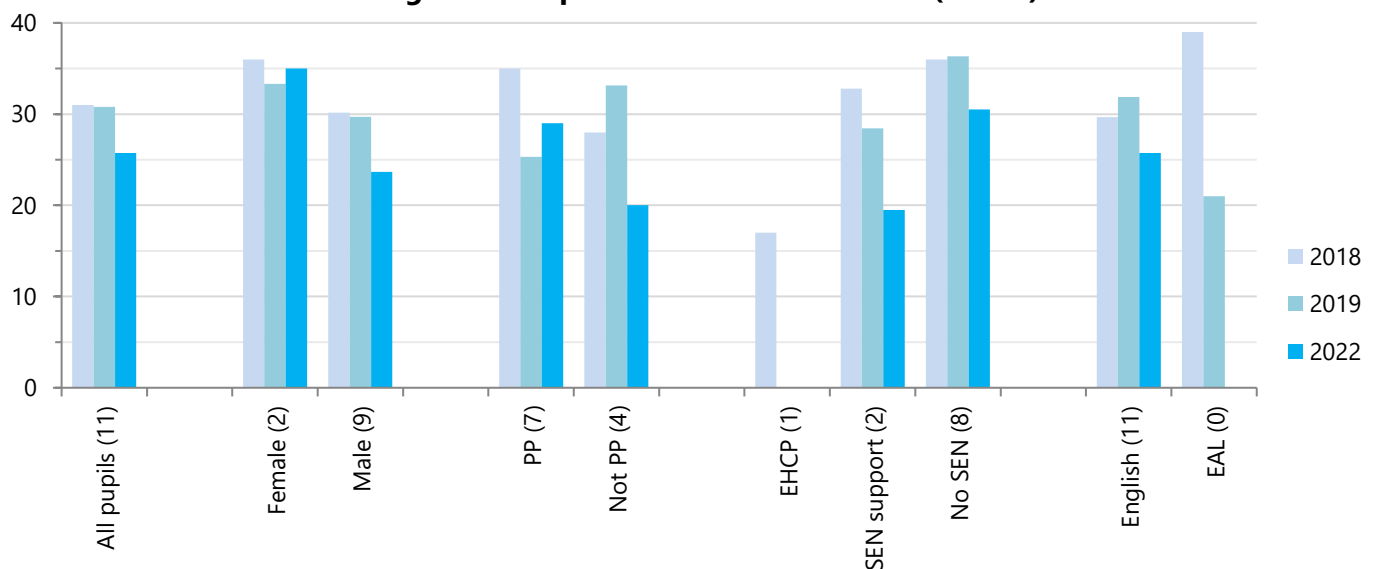

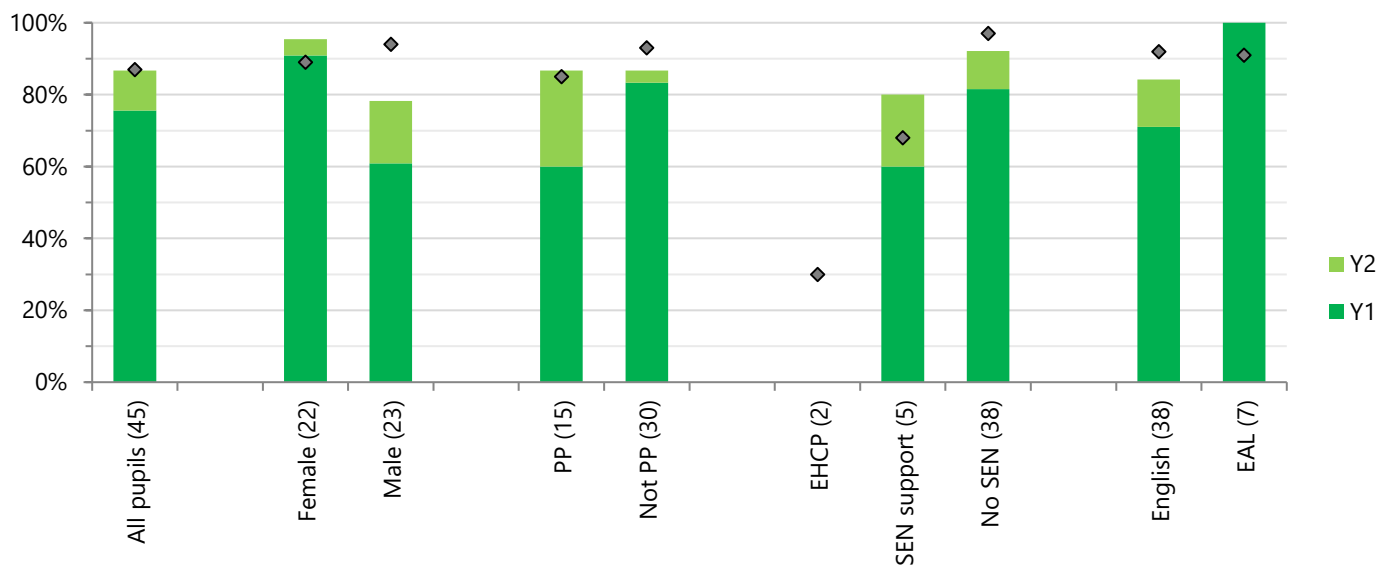
Average mark in phonics standard in Year 2 (re-sits)



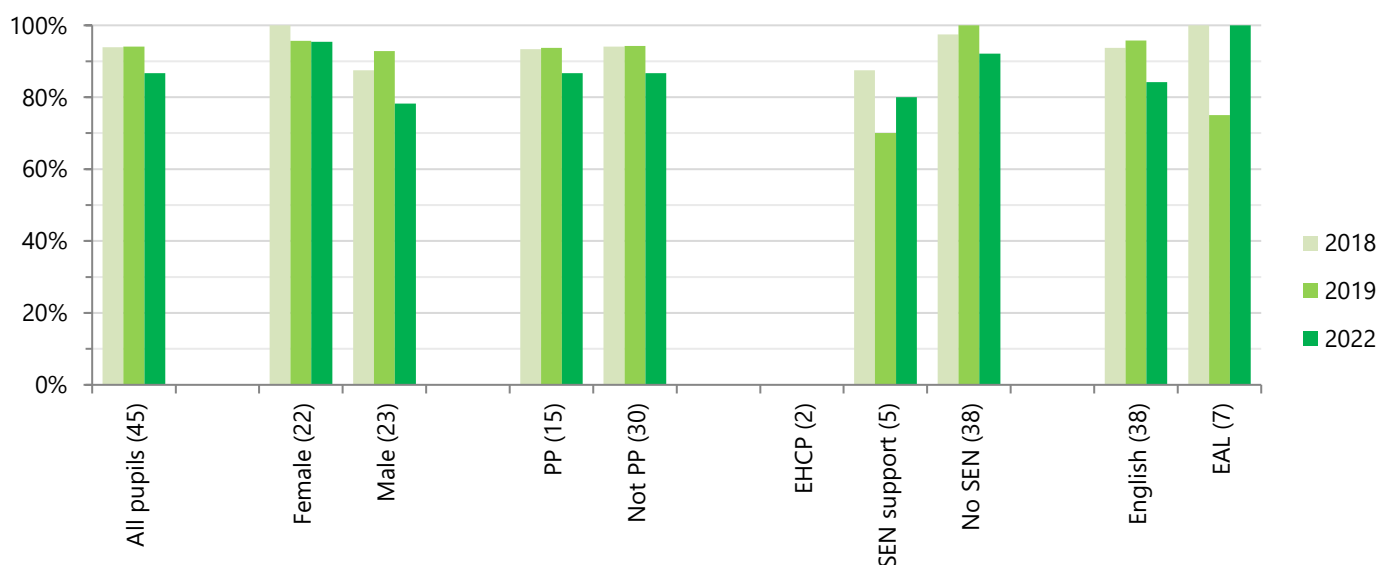

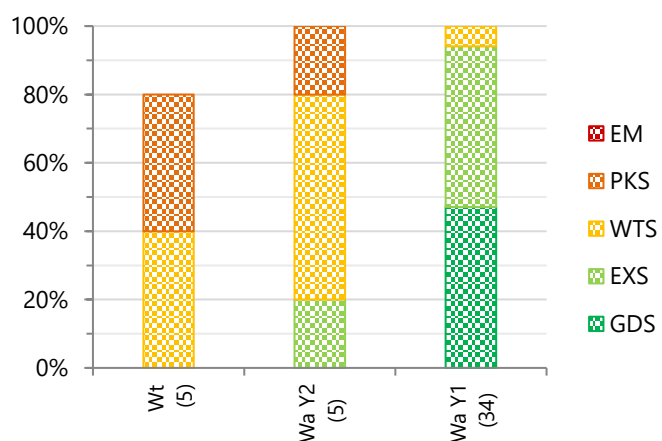
Pupils meeting the expected standard in KS1 reading TA over time



Transition from EYFS to KS1 reading



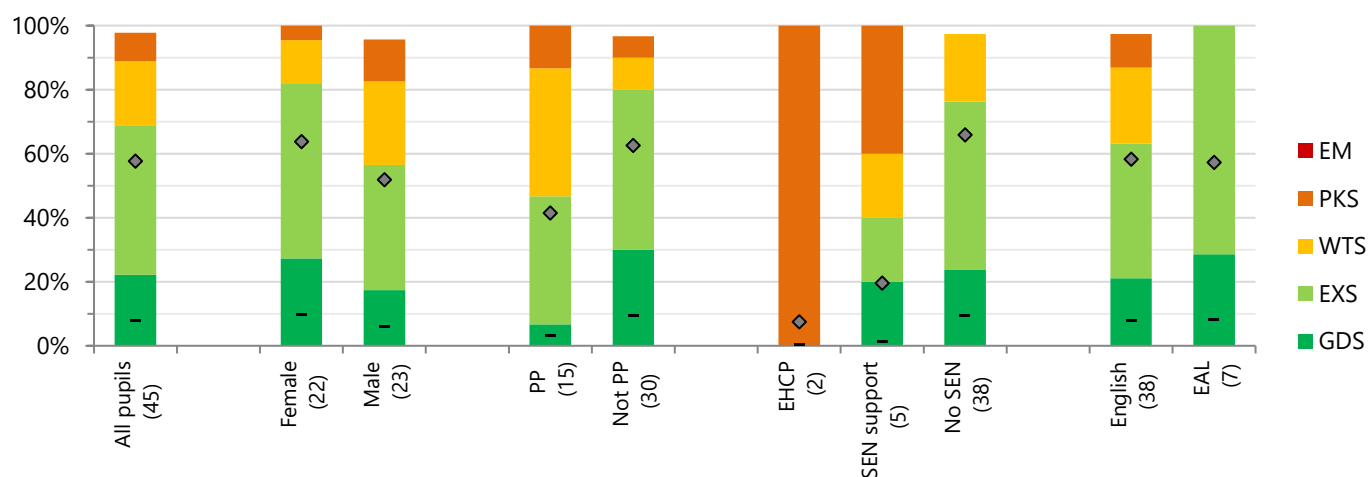
Transition from phonics to KS1 reading



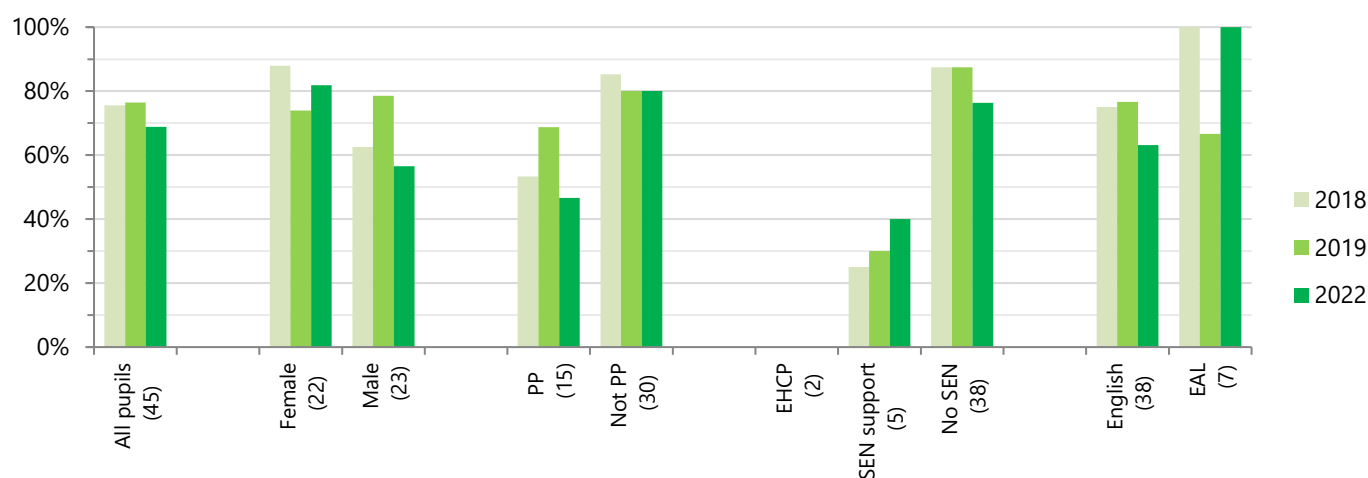

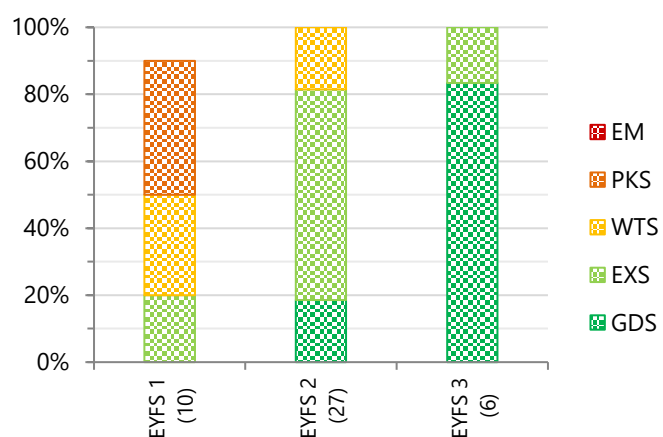

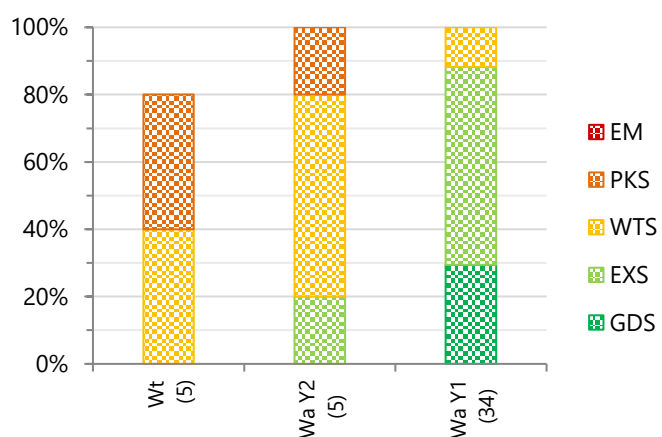
Pupils meeting the expected standard in KS1 writing TA over time



Transition from EYFS to KS1 writing



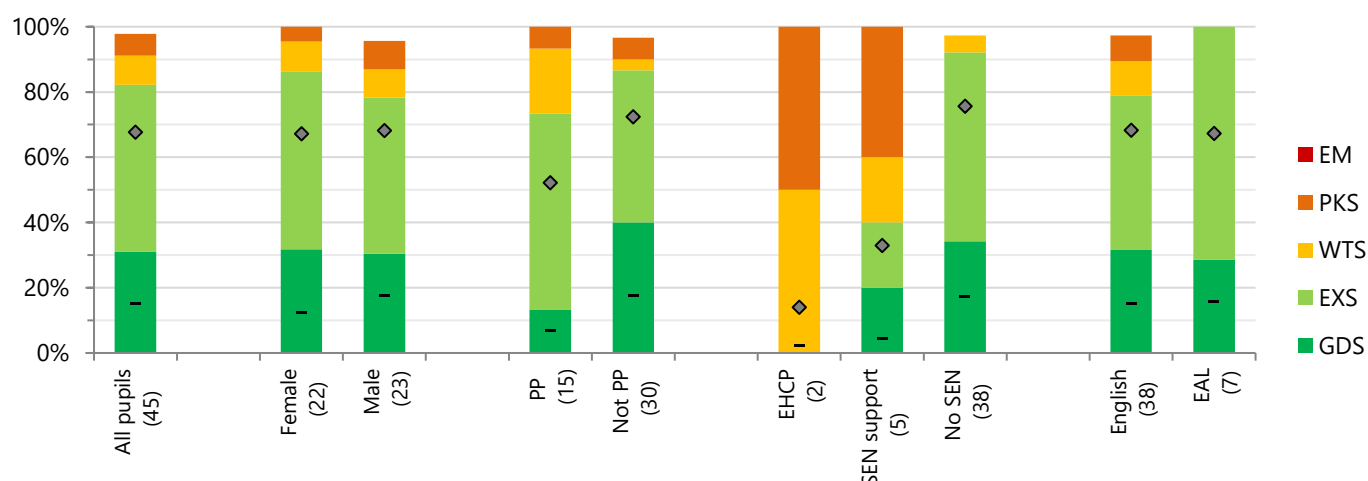
Transition from phonics to KS1 writing



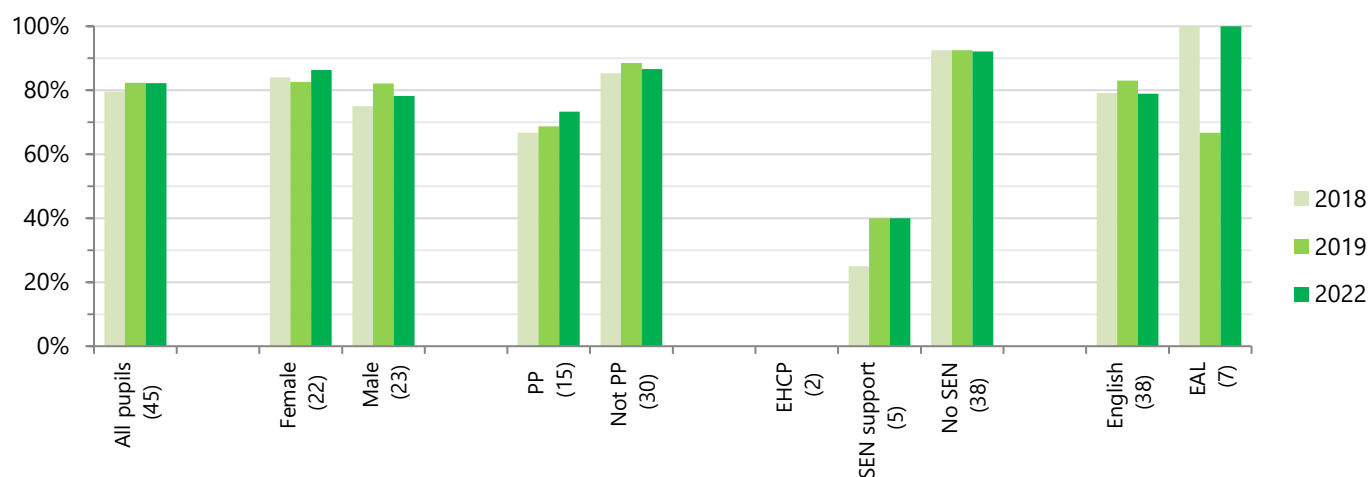

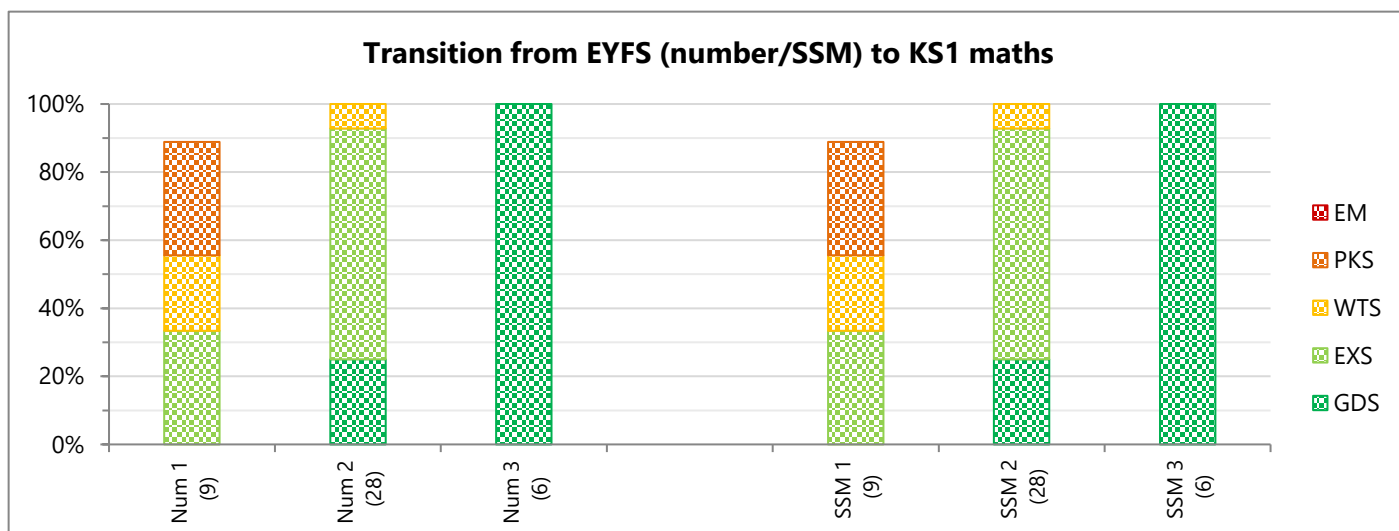

Pupils meeting the expected standard in KS1 maths TA over time

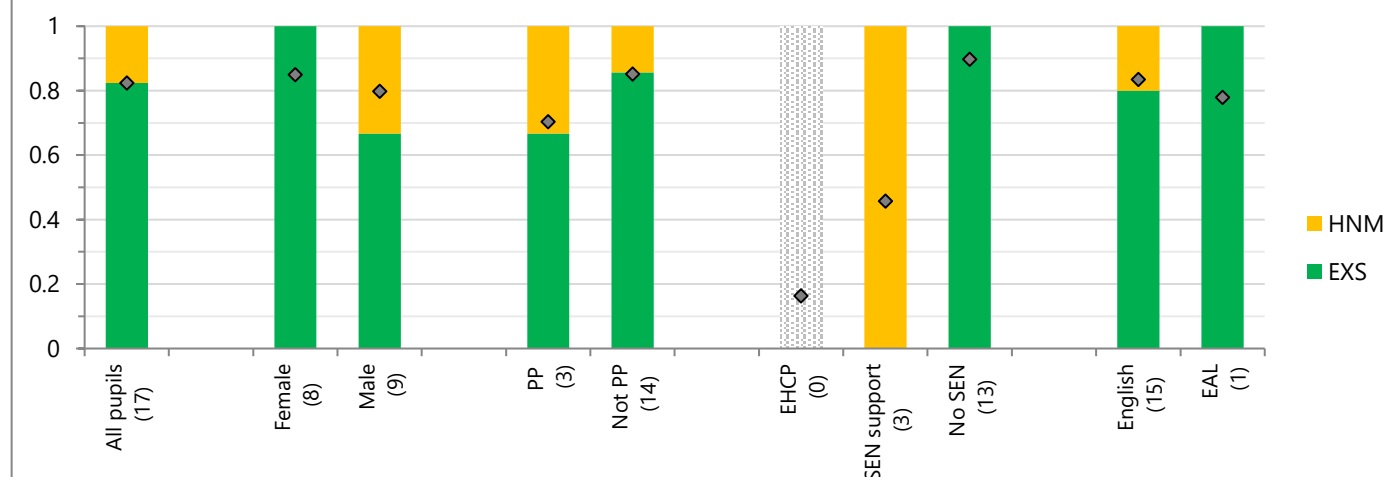




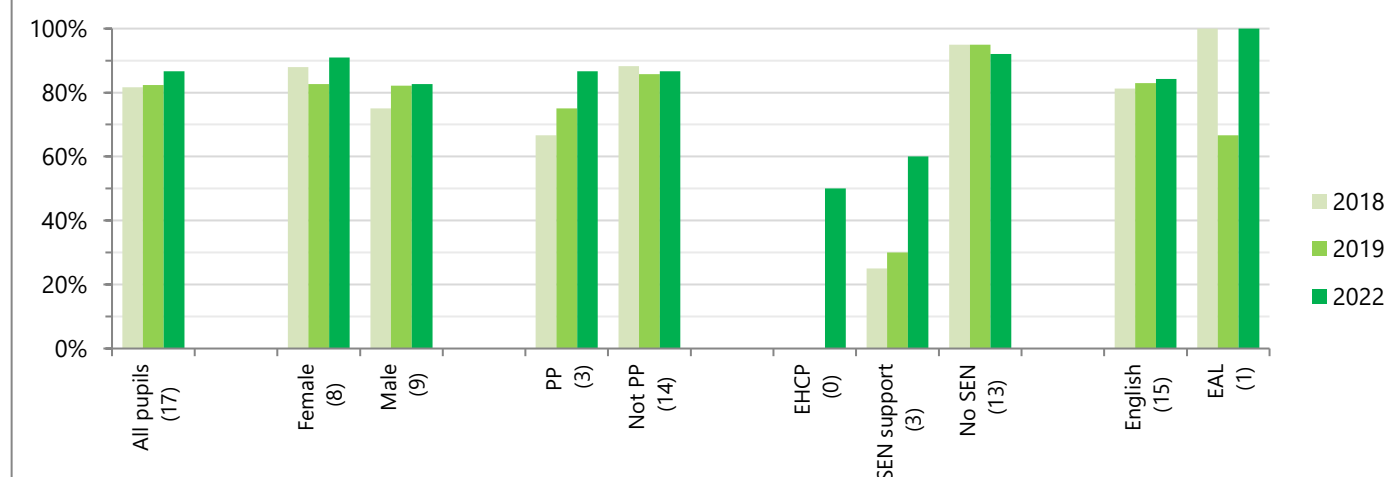

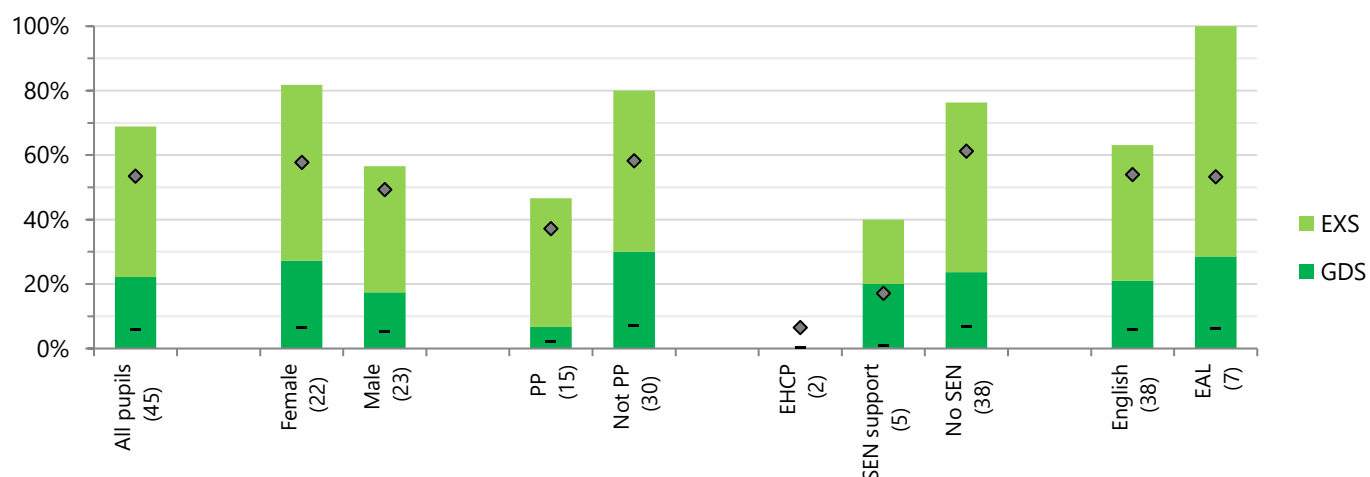
Pupils meeting the expected standard in KS1 science TA over time



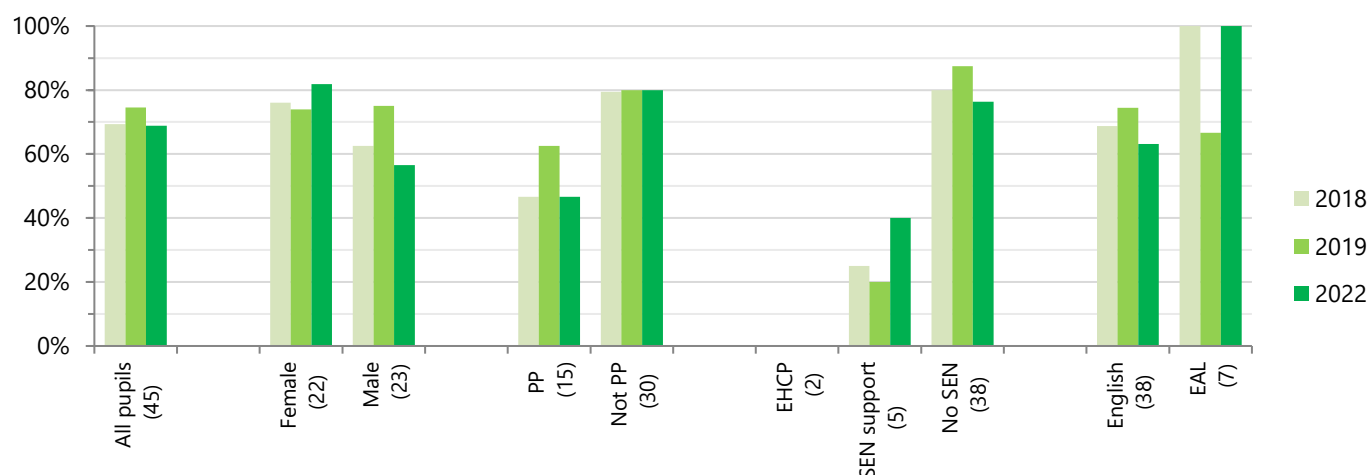

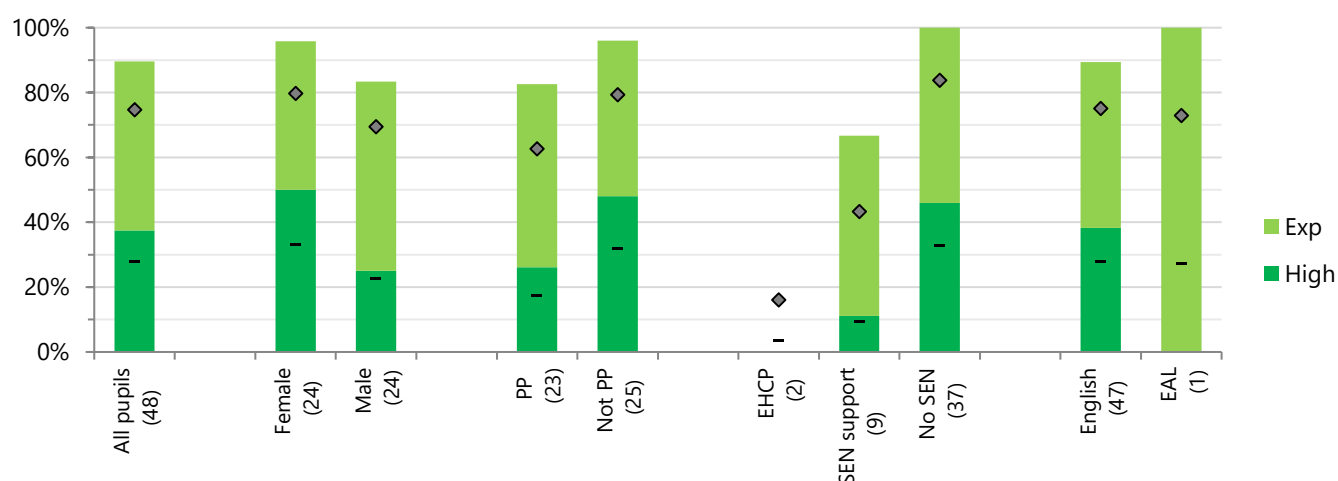
Pupils meeting the expected standard in KS1 RW&M over time



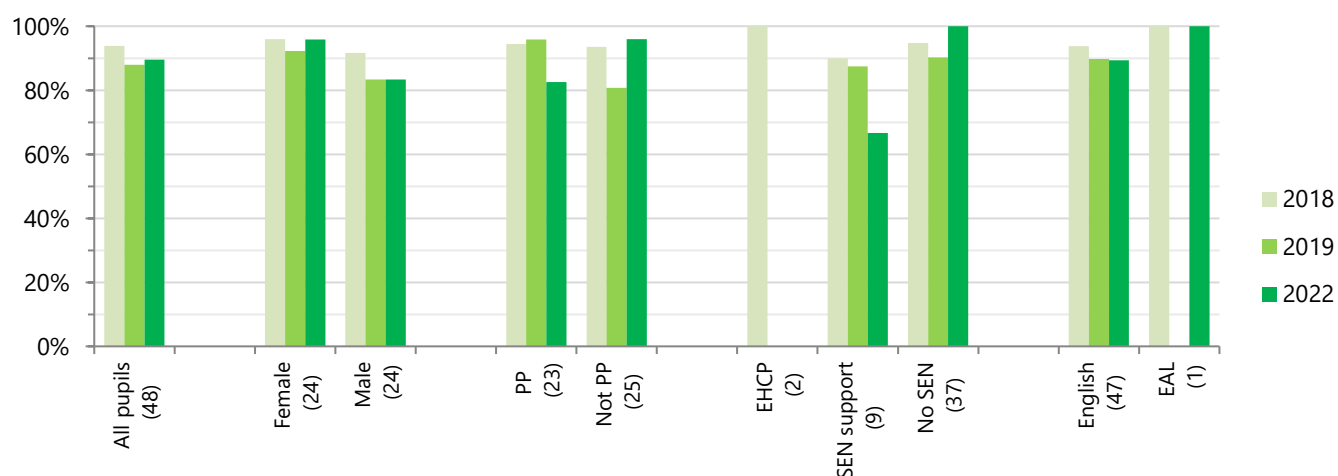

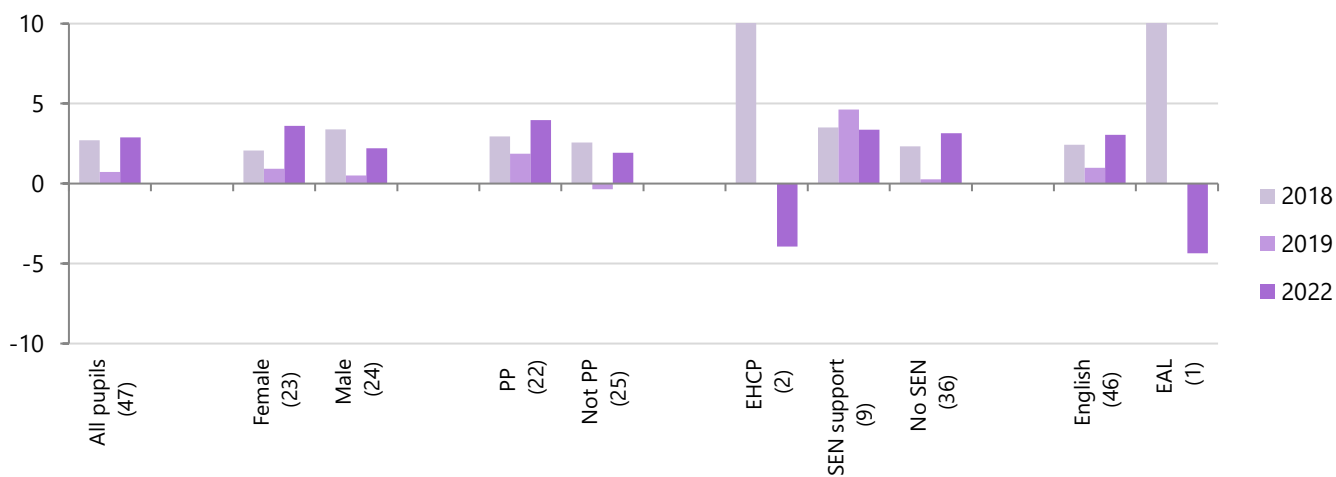


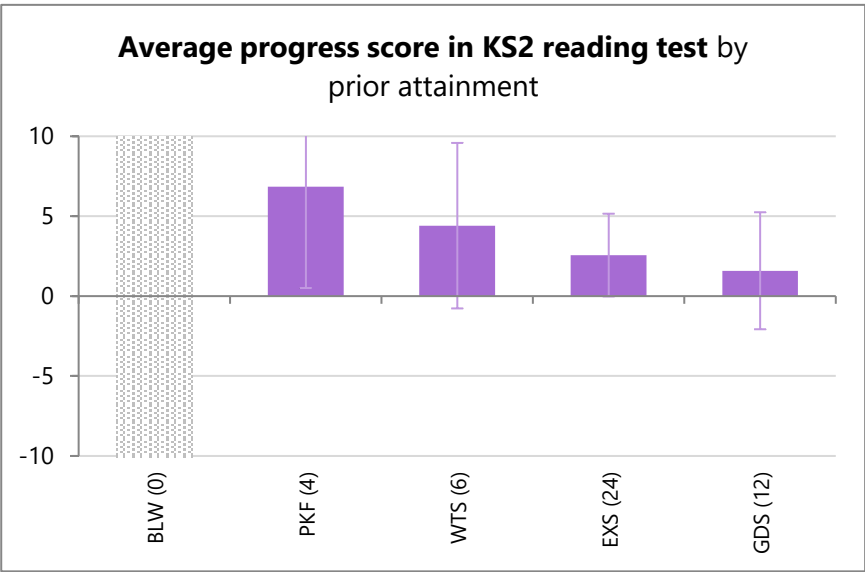
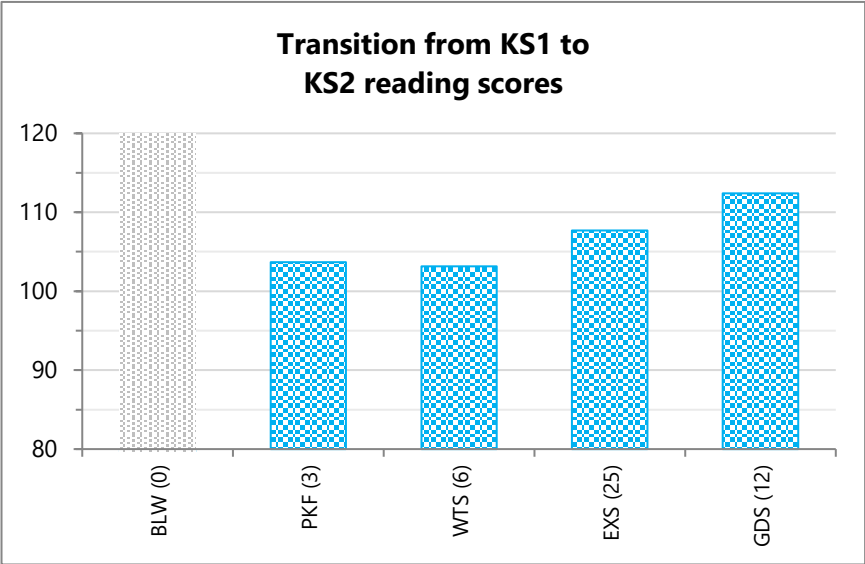
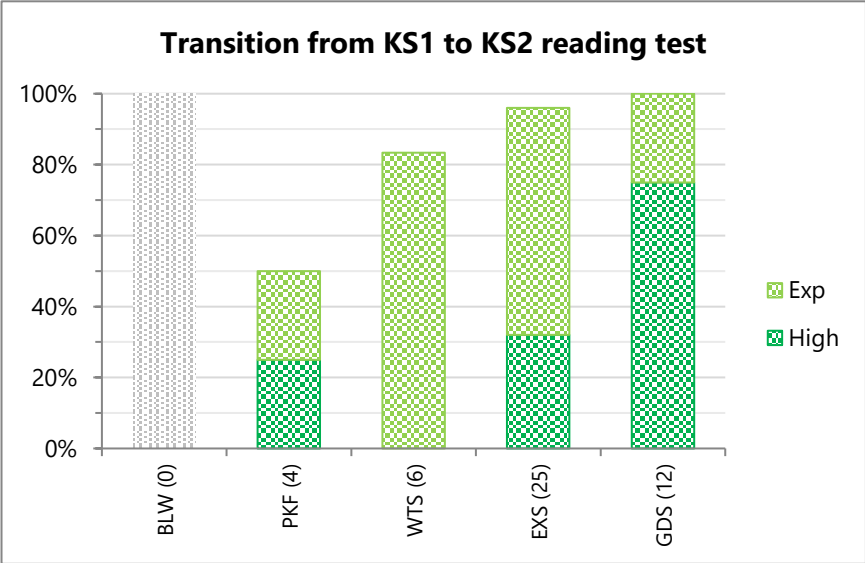


Average progress score in the KS2 reading test



Average progress score in KS2 reading over time

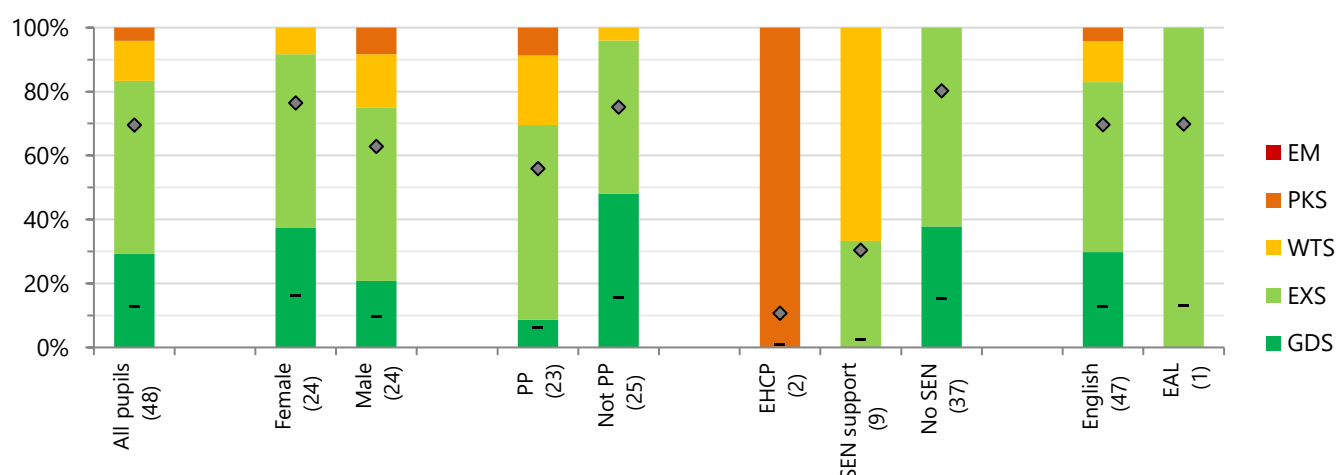




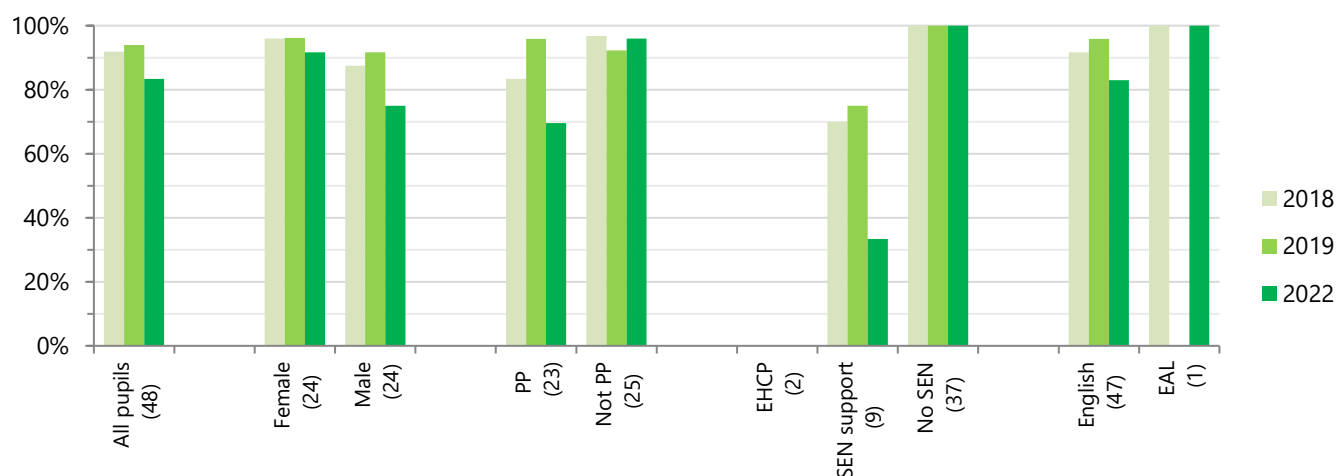

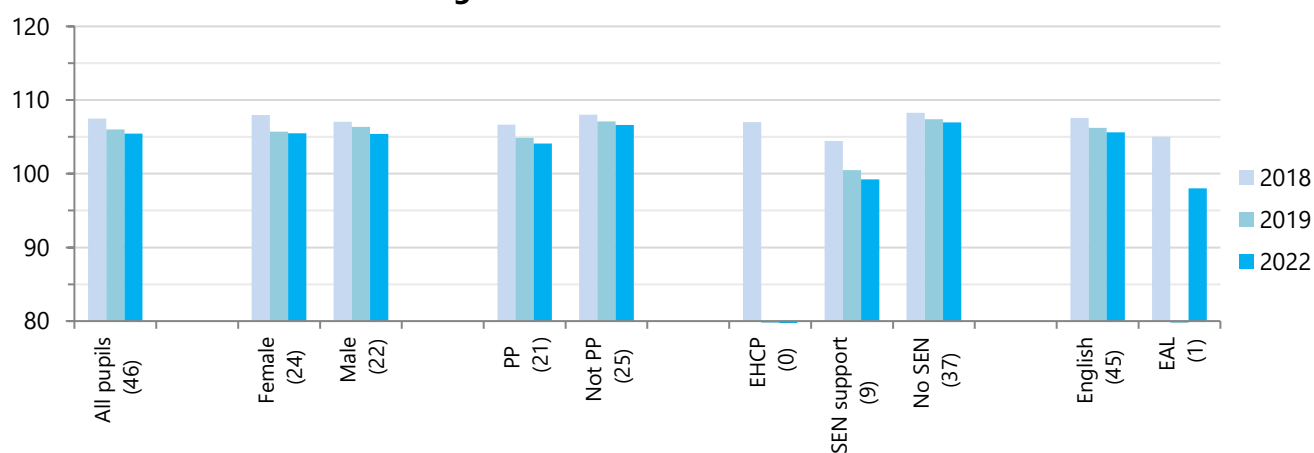
% passing the KS2 maths test over time

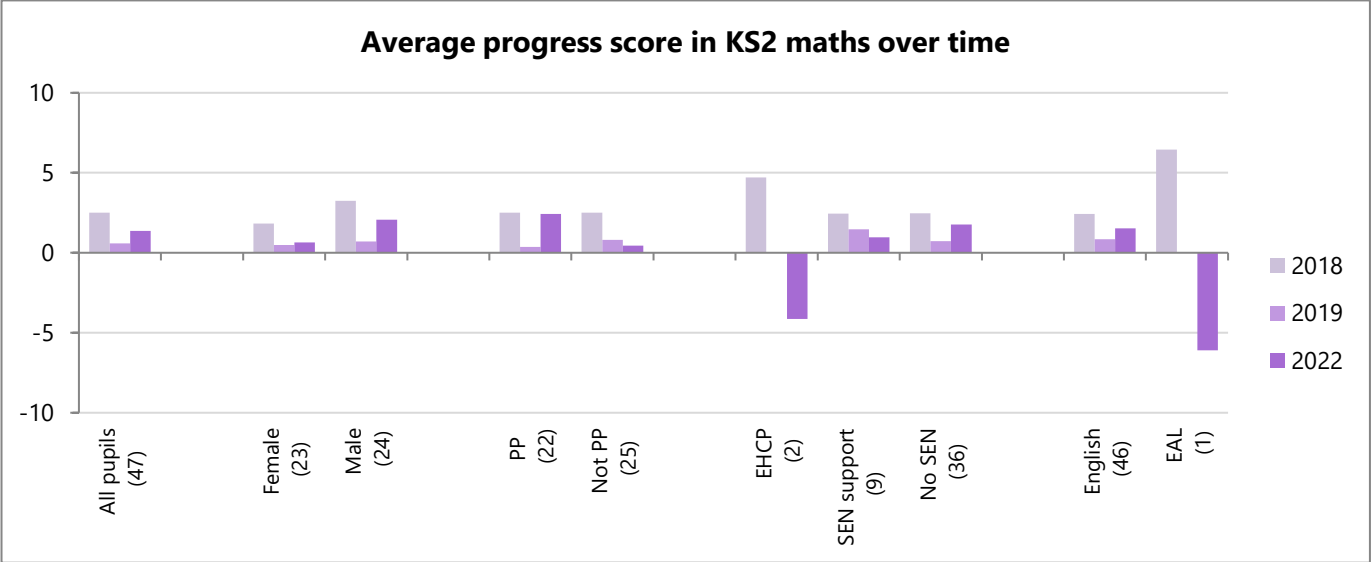
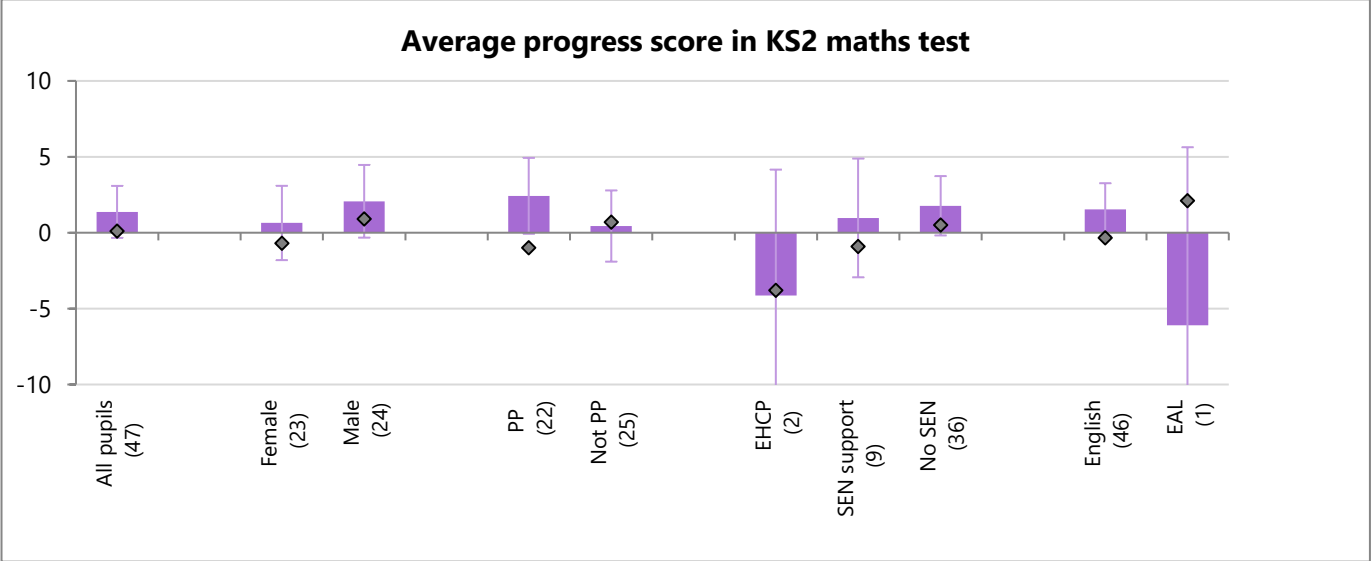


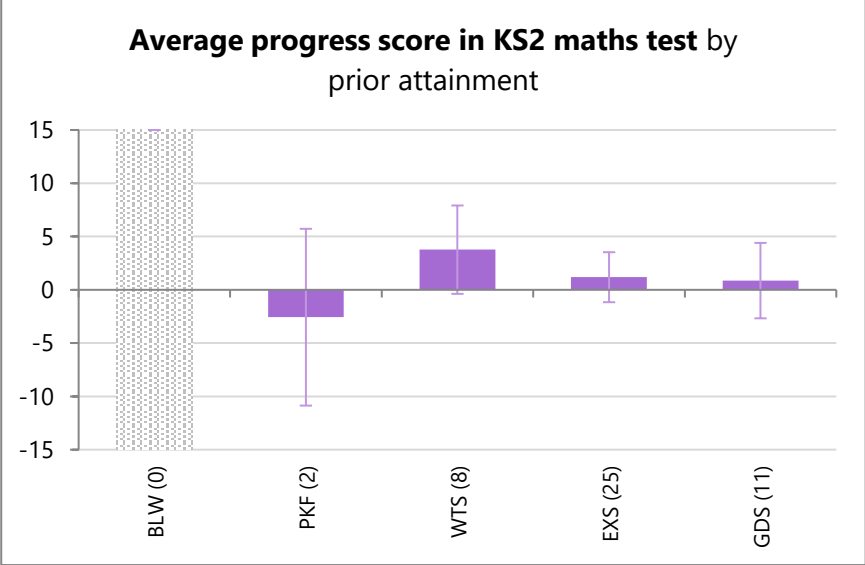
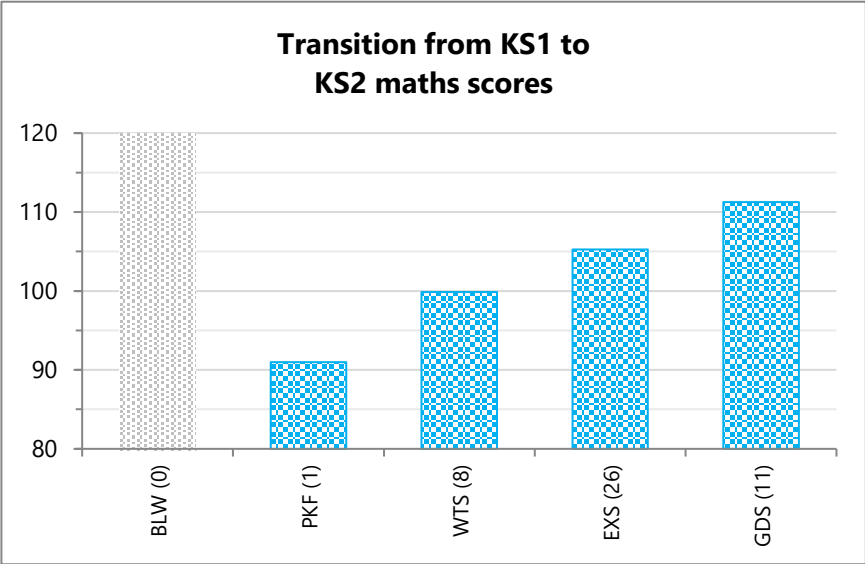
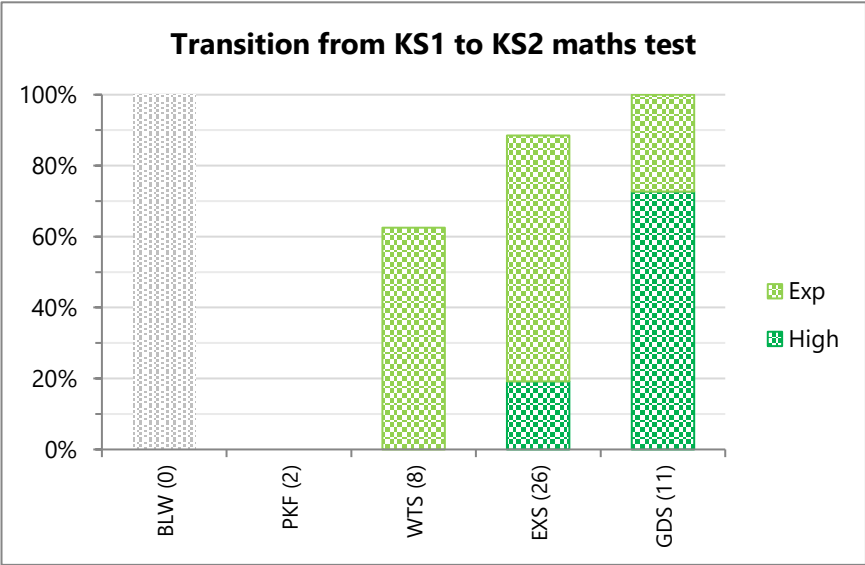
Average scaled score in the KS2 maths test



Average scaled score in KS2 maths over time

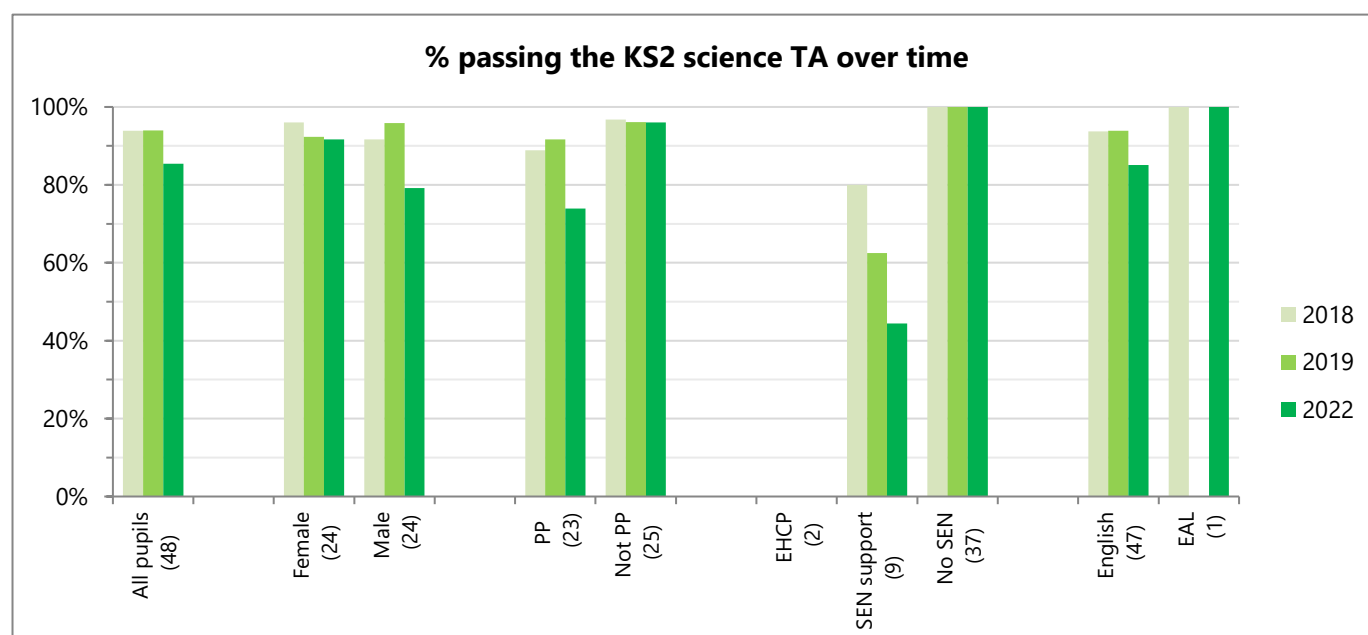
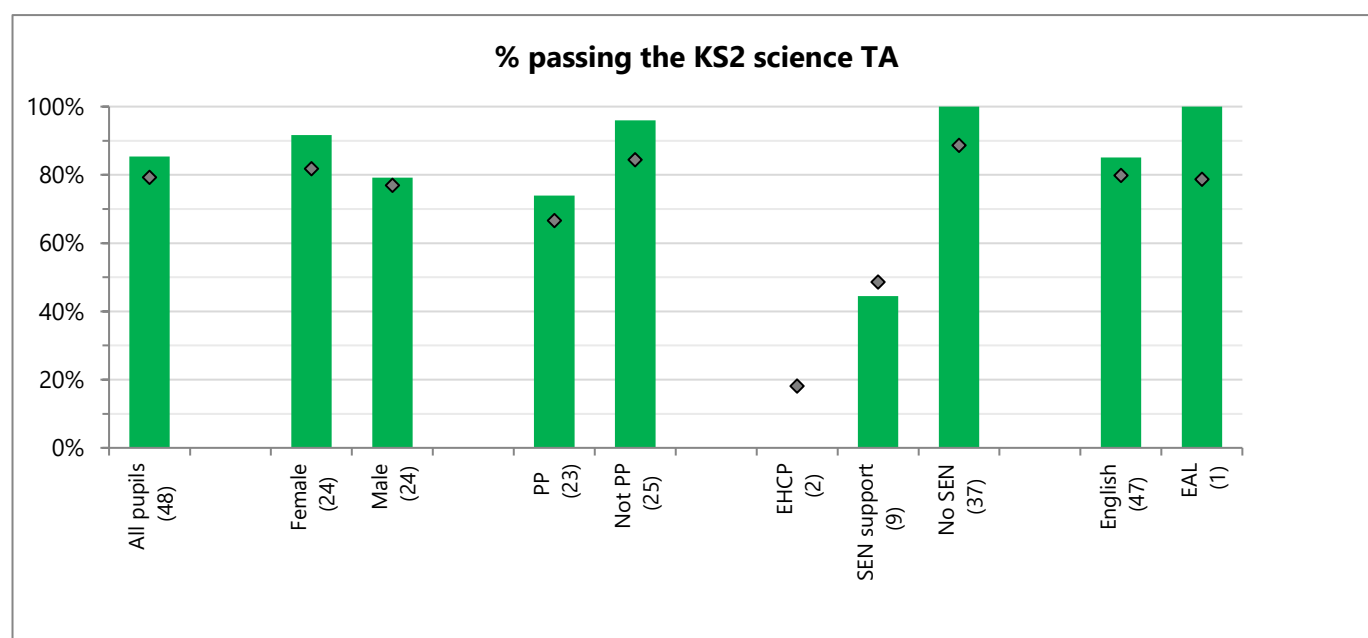


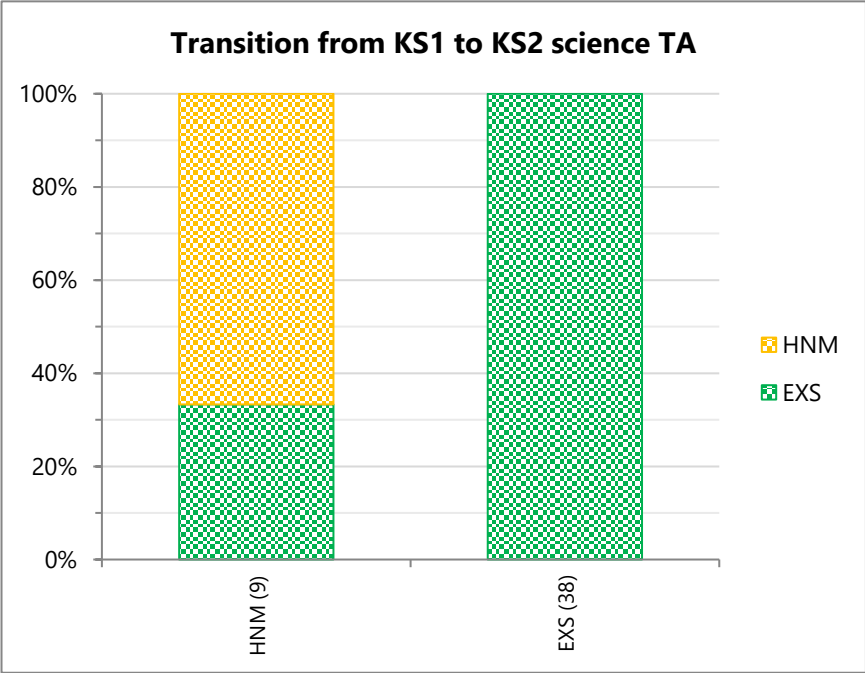

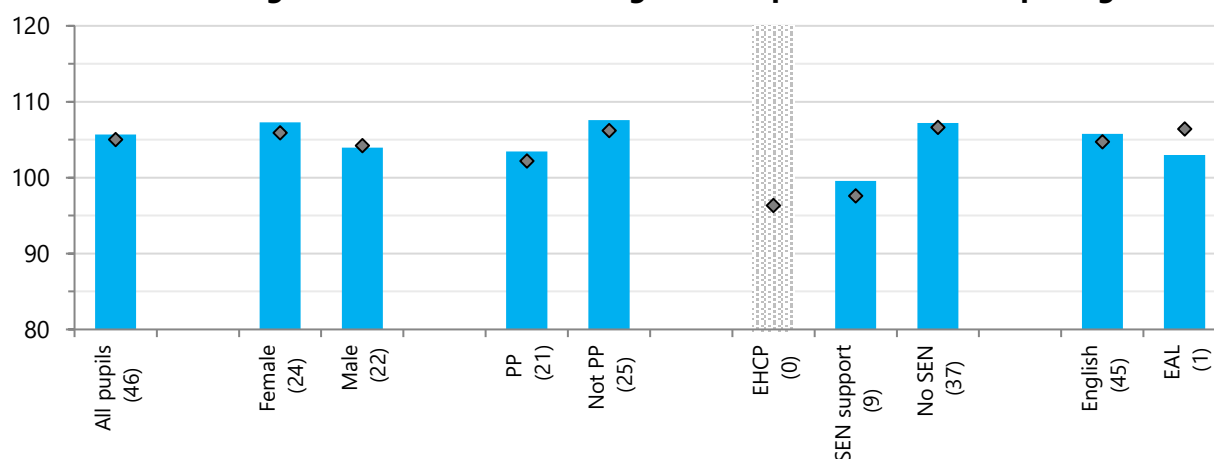

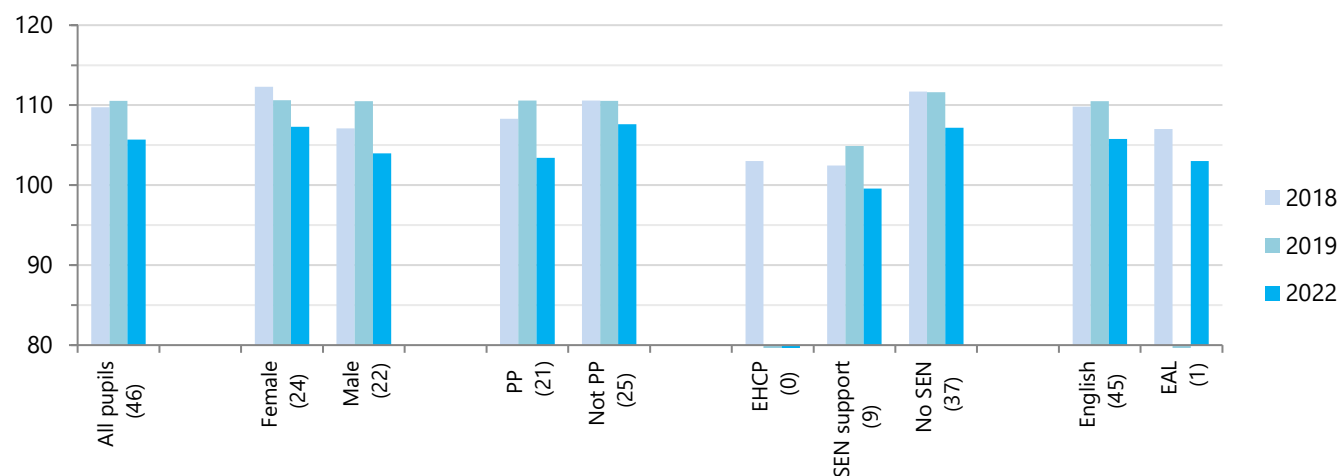
% passing the KS2 grammar, punctuation and spelling test over time



Average scaled score in the KS2 grammar, punctuation and spelling test



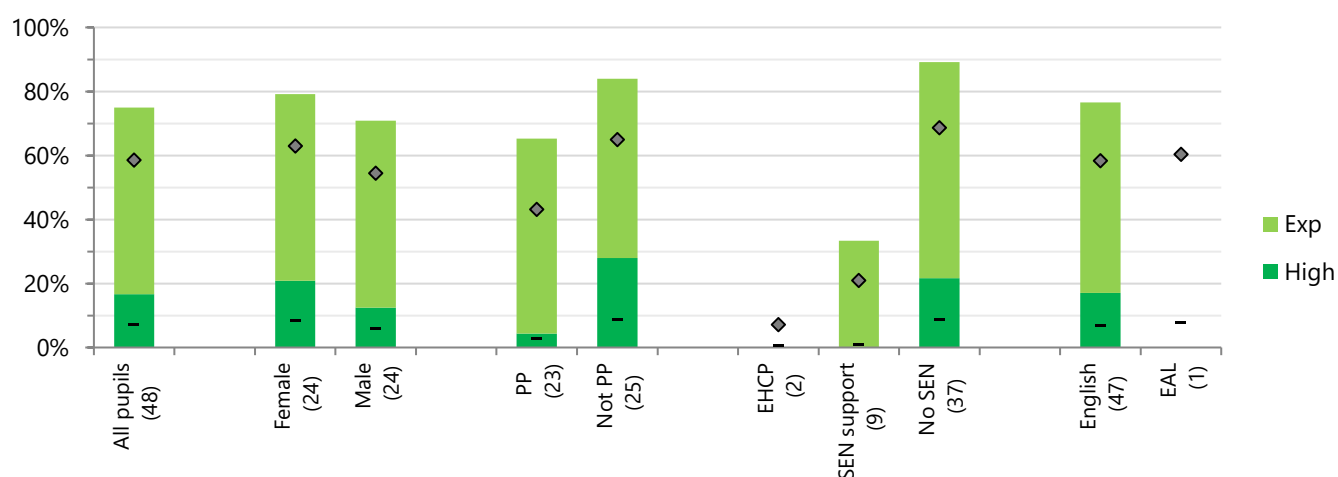
Average scaled score in the KS2 grammar, punctuation and spelling over time
